



Sample Course Planner Fall 2011

This is a sample course planner for Business students entering into SFU in Fall 2011. The planner includes five course suggestions per semester. However, the tri-mester system at SFU allows students to spread out their course requirements over three semesters within a year. It is recommended that students *only take three to four courses per semester in their first year*. If students take ten courses per academic year, they will finish their degree requirements in four years.

First Year in the Beedie School of Business

In the first year of study, it is strongly recommended that students at both campuses enroll into the **BusOne** option. This pathway includes the regular BBA courses required for degree completion but adds an additional weekly workshop that will introduce students to the services and opportunities available within the Business program. Business students at the Surrey campus will complete courses in one of the following entry pathways: BusOne; Explorations or FLC's in the Arts; or in one of two Science programs. These integrated, first-year programs provide the knowledge base necessary for students seeking to Major in Business.

Second Year (Sample Only)

Students will gain a comprehensive Business background through the lower level Business courses and electives in their first two years of study. It is strongly recommended that students visit a Business Advisor before enrolling in second year courses so that they can make a course plan that best fits their needs and the BBA degree requirements.

Third and Fourth Year
