

A Major in Business Administration requires a minimum of 120 units which must include the following specific course and unit requirements:

Course requirements:

During the first half of a student's degree (1-60 units) the following course requirements would normally be completed: (Sections a-d)

a) Lower Division Requirements

- Bus 207-3 - Managerial Economics (or Econ 301-4)*
- Buec 232-4 - Data and Decisions I (or Stats 270)
- Bus 237-3 - Introduction to Computers and Information Systems in Business
- Bus 251-3 - Financial Accounting I
- Bus 254-3 - Managerial Accounting I*
- Bus 272-3 - Behavior in Organizations
- Econ 103-4 - Principles of Microeconomics
- Econ 105-4 - Principles of Macroeconomics
- Math 157-3 - Calculus for the Social Sciences I (or Math 150-4, 151-3 or 154-3)

And any two of***:

- Engl 101-3 - Introduction to Fiction
- Engl 102-3 - Introduction to Poetry
- Engl 103-3 - Introduction to Drama
- Engl 104-3 - Introduction to Prose Genres
- Engl 105-3 - Introduction to Issues in Literature and Culture
- Engl 199-3 - Introduction to University Writing
- Phil 001-3 - Critical Thinking
- Phil 100-3 - Knowledge and Reality
- Phil 120-3 - Introduction to Moral Philosophy
- WL 101W-3 - Writing About Literature
- WL 103W-3 - Pre-Modern World Literature
- WL 104W-3 - Modern World Literature

*Not required for admission to program.

**Lower division courses must have a minimum grade of C- to meet graduation requirements.

***Transfer Credit assigned as ENGL 1XX CAN be used in place of any of the English courses. Transfer credit assigned as PHIL 1XX CAN NOT be used in place of any of the Philosophy courses.

b) Writing, Quantitative and Breadth Requirements (WQB) - For students admitted to SFU Fall 06 onward

Writing

Students are required to complete 6 units of "W" course work in their degree, one of which must be an upper division (300 or 400 level) course. All the English courses and Phil 100W and Phil 120W, of which you need 2 for admission to SFU Business, are "W" courses. BUS 360W, a Business Core Course, will meet the Writing Upper Division requirement.

Quantitative

Students are required to complete 6 units of "Q" course work in their degree. Since 6 courses required for the BBA are designated "Q" courses, students will meet this requirement while completing their BBA.

Bachelor of Business Administration : Major

Breadth

Students are required to complete 24 units of “B” course work in their degree.

- 6 units of Social Sciences (B-Soc)
- 6 units of Humanities (B-Hum)
- 6 units of Science (B-Sc)
- 6 units of Undesignated Breadth (UB) - can be met within the 50 Non-BUS or non-BUEC units requirement

c) 50 units of non-Business, non-Buec courses

Students must complete a minimum of 50 units of non-Bus or non-Buec courses within their degree requirement. These courses are generally, though not necessarily, completed in the first half of a degree and may be at any level. For example: Math 157. These units would normally come from categories a), b) and d).

d) Group Requirements for student admitted to SFU before Fall 2006:

Group A

Students must complete four courses from at least two departments from the

following: Contemporary Arts, English, General Studies, History, Humanities, Languages, Linguistics, Philosophy. (Engl/Phil courses from Lower Division requirements will complete two courses).

Group B

Students must complete four courses from at least two departments from the following: Archaeology, Asia-Canada, Canadian Studies, Communication, Criminology, Economics, Education, Geography (excluding all Physical Geography courses), Gerontology, Latin American Development Studies, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology and Anthropology, Women's Studies. (Econ 103 and 105 will complete two courses).

Group C

Students must complete two courses from the following: Biochemistry, Biological Sciences, Chemistry, Computing Science, Earth Sciences, Kinesiology, Mathematics, Physical Geography: (Geog 111, 112, 213, 214, 215, 311, 313, 314, 315, 317, 412, 413, 414, 415, 416, 417, 418, 419), Physics, Statistics.

Note: Lower division requirements may count towards Group Requirements.

(i.e. Econ 103 may count as a Grp B; and Math 157 may count as a Grp C)

Also, group requirements can be at any level, whether it be 100+ to 400+ level course.

Unit requirements:

During the **last half** of a student's degree (**61-120 units**) the following course unit requirements must be met:

45 units of upper division course work

of which 36 units must be Bus or Buec

of which 9 units may be from any program, Business or otherwise

15 units of lower or upper division course work

from any program, Business or otherwise.

In addition the following course requirements would normally be completed: (Sections e-i)

e) Business core courses

Require all of:

- Bus 303-3 - Business, Society and Ethics
- Bus 312-4 - Introduction to Finance
- Bus 336-4 - Data and Decisions II
- Bus 343-3 - Introduction to Marketing
- Bus 360W-4 - Business Communication *
- Bus 393-3 - Commercial Law

Bachelor of Business Administration : Major

- Bus 478-3 - Seminar in Administrative Policy **

and one of:

- Bus 374-3 - Organization Theory
- Bus 381-3 - Introduction to Human Resource Management

Core courses must have a minimum grade of C- to meet graduation requirements.

* It is recommended that students complete Bus 360 before their 75th unit. Students must take Bus 360W at SFU in accordance with WQB requirements.

** To be completed at SFU.

f) Area of Concentration

Students are required to complete at least one area of concentration in their program. More than one area is optional. Courses that are listed in two areas (i.e. Bus 418 is listed in both Finance and International Business) will count towards the requirements of both areas. The concentrations which are available within our program are:

- Accounting - Honours
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation
- Finance
- International Business
- Human Resource Management
- Management Information Systems
- Operations Management
- Marketing

g) Bus 400+ level course requirement

Students are required to complete at least three 400+ level Business or Buec courses within their degree. This requirement is usually met within a student's area(s) of concentration. At least one of these 400 level classes must be completed at SFU.

Bus 478 and the Bus 425 co-op practicum will not count towards this requirement.
