



A Minor in Business Administration requires the following:

- a) Lower division requirements
- b) Business Cores
- c) Business Electives at the 300+ or 400+ levels

In the last half of the degree, a student must complete 16 units of Upper Division Business or Buec work which would come from categories b) and c).

a) Lower Division Requirements

- Buec 232-4 - Data and Decisions I (or Stats 270)
- Bus 237-3 - Introduction to Computers and Information Systems in Business
- Bus 251-3 - Financial Accounting I
- Bus 254-3 Managerial Accounting I*
- Bus 272-3 - Behavior in Organizations
- Econ 103-4 - Principles of Microeconomics
- Econ 105-4 - Principles of Macroeconomics
- Math157-3 - Calculus for the Social Sciences I (or Math 150-4, 151-3 or 154-3)

*Not required for admission to program.

**Lower division courses must have a minimum grade of C- to meet graduation requirements.

b) Business core courses

- Bus 312-4 - Introduction to Finance
- Bus 343-3 - Introduction to Marketing

and one of:

- Bus 374-3 - Organization Theory
- Bus 381-3 - Introduction to Human Resource Management

Core courses must have a minimum grade of C- to meet graduation requirements.

c) Bus or Buec 300+ or 400+ electives

Students are required to complete 16 units of Upper Division Business in the final 60 units of their degree. The core courses mentioned in b) will complete 10 of the required 16. The remaining 6 units may be fulfilled by Business or Buec 300+ or 400+ electives.
