

Life Beyond Individual Choice: Group Behaviour in Television Audiences¹

Abstract

Groups differ from individuals in their viewing behaviours, and these differences are strongly moderated by the serial character of the program watched. Larger groups show properties that make them good candidates to explore new dimensions in audience analysis, and as indicators of loyalty.
