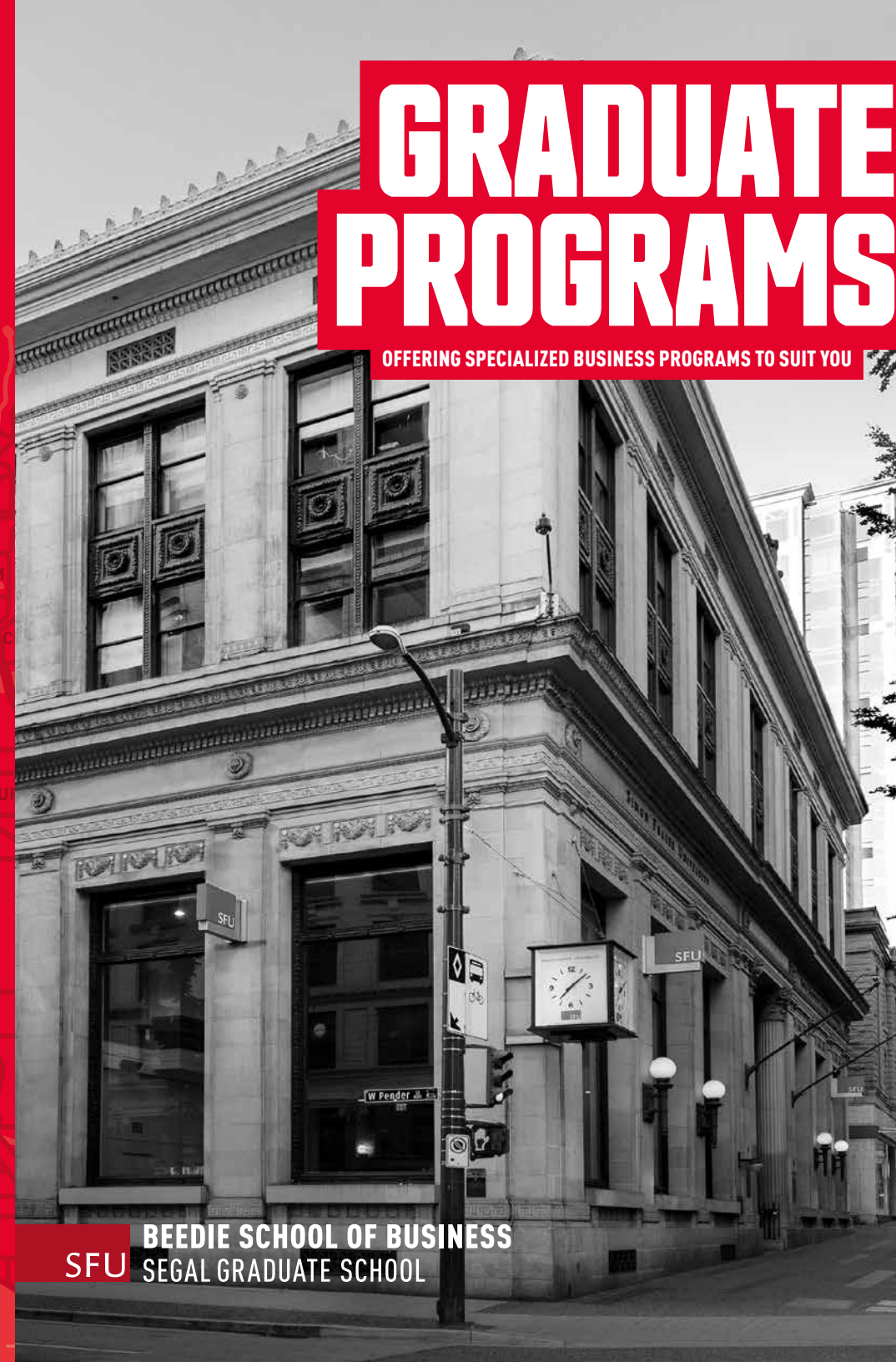

- An undergraduate degree: min 3.0 CGPA. Exceptional managers who lack a formal degree or professional designation and do not meet this requirement, but have strong leadership experience may be considered.
- Proficiency in English for ESL candidates: TOEFL 93+ or IELTS 7+

- Tuition: \$56,100

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Business experience: 5 to 10 years of work experience, with at least four of those years in a managerial or professional position.
- Academic achievements: An undergrad degree in any discipline. A two-year diploma and outstanding grades will be considered. A limited number of people who lack a formal degree or professional designation, but have other outstanding qualifications may be admitted.

TUITION & FEES

- Tuition: \$55,500
- Includes all course materials, off-site orientation and workshops.
